**Ages: 2-5** 

Two-year-olds who have attended the MSW Beginnings program are eligible to attend summer camp.

During morning hours, campers will follow the typical Montessori morning program using materials from the various curriculum areas in the room with an influence centered on the weekly camp topics. Children under age four staying during afternoon camp hours will use our napping program. Campers four and older who do not nap will continue in the classroom with an age-appropriate focus on a variety of structured arts, crafts, and outside activities as well as time for free play.

Ages: Rising first graders - 11

During morning hours, campers will focus on the weekly camp topics. Afternoon campers will continue in the classroom with a special focus on structured arts, crafts, and outside activities as well as time for free play.
